

**An Order of Daily Prayer for use with the  
Weekly Prayer diary for the Parish of Calne and Blackland.**

(Based on "Prayer During the Day on Tuesday"  
from Common Worship Daily Prayer.)

**Instructions for the use of this order of daily prayer.**

*If praying this order on your own read all the parts, both light type and bold type. If praying in a group of two or more decide who will 'lead', they will read the text in light type. Then all will join in with the text in bold type. Do take time to reflect on the Psalm and Bible reading at that point in the liturgy.*

**Preparation**

O God, make speed to save us.

**All O Lord, make haste to help us.**

To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.

**All O my God, in you I trust.**

**Praise**

**I am giving you worship with all my life,**

**I am giving you obedience with all my power,**

**I am giving you praise with all my strength,**

**I am giving you honour with all my speech.**

**I am giving you love with all my heart,**

**I am giving you affection with all my sense,**

**I am giving you my soul, O most high and holy God.**
